Intergenerational family learning - future developments, working across parents, carers, grandparents any family members
FL classes in Community Learning Programme (Cartoon Drawing, Upholstery etc.)

Book bug - expanded to take out to areas where individuals would not go out to libraries- targeting particular areas and learners with follow on family activities.

Learning Partnerships - respond to local needs, eg Soup Project - work with parents/children to make soup, cooking on a budget, then sit down to have a meal (Shetland)

HIGHLAND Family Learning Programme- anti-poverty initiative, providing lunchclub - expanded to become a hub for the community. Partially for kids but 2 days a week family sessions such as cookery / arts / coffee & worksheet

Aberdeen city - ongoing 121's. group work, walk and talk, peep training, outdoor learning, STEM, contribution to the LA literacy policy highlighting parental literacy as a key indicator for Family and childrens literacy

Inter-generational digital skills project involving young people in youth clubs, teaching their parents, grandparents in a youth club setting (Shetland)

Aberdeen Parental Involvement & Engagement Strategy 2021-2024 provides a framework for work.

Aberdeen City - dedicated Parental engagement worker - sited in Education. Less family learning than information sessions and Parent forum support

Delivered some FL sessions harnessing STEM professional Learning

Aberdeen City work within Fit Like hubs referral process - equal partner championing the CLD approach with families.

HIGHLAND - Funded trips. Tomorrow taking families to Botanic gardens for outdoor learning/literacy and lunch.

Aberdeen City - FL team significant additional investment post covid via Education Recovery fund. linked to associated schools groups.
